

# PARTS OF SPEECH

interj noun verb adj noun adverb conj adverb verb pron adj adj noun prep adj noun  
ex. **Hey Harry, put that torch down, and carefully hand me the biggest wrench in the set.**

Interjection - hey! Wow! Congratulations! Yes! etc. Boy! that was a great game.

Verb - action or state-of-being word. Bob hit the ball. Bob is happy.

Noun – person, place, thing, idea, quality, or concept Terry expressed his happiness through meditation.

Pronoun - substitute for noun - he, it, I, our, everyone, etc. Everyone loved his letter to me.

Adjective - describes or modifies noun or pronoun - Bob was a good runner.

Adverb - describes or modifies verb, adjective, or other adverb The very big man ran quite well.

Preposition - connects noun to the sentence - of, with, for, after etc. Bob swam in the pool.  
(anywhere a mouse can go)

Conjunction - connects words and phrases and clauses Because Jim and Sam don't swim, we stayed home.  
coordinating - FANBOYS, (For And Nor But Or Yet So)  
subordinating - after, because
